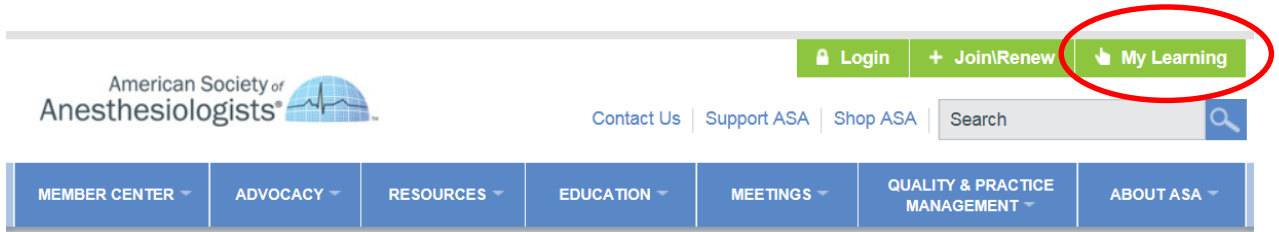

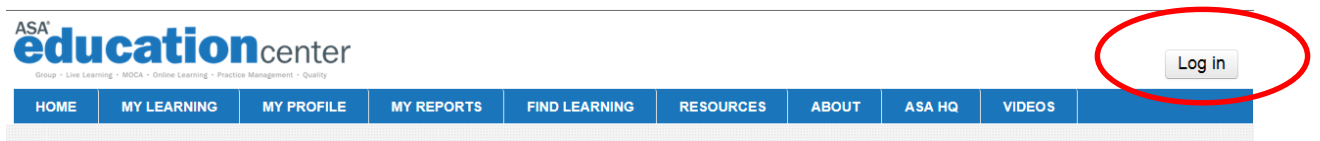
Listed below are instructions to submit your responses, complete the course evaluation and claim your CME credit for **SEE 32A Booklet** version.

1. Go to www.asahq.org.

- Select the **My Learning** button at the top right of the page.

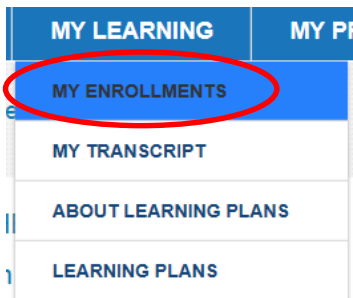


- Select **Log in** at the top of the page.



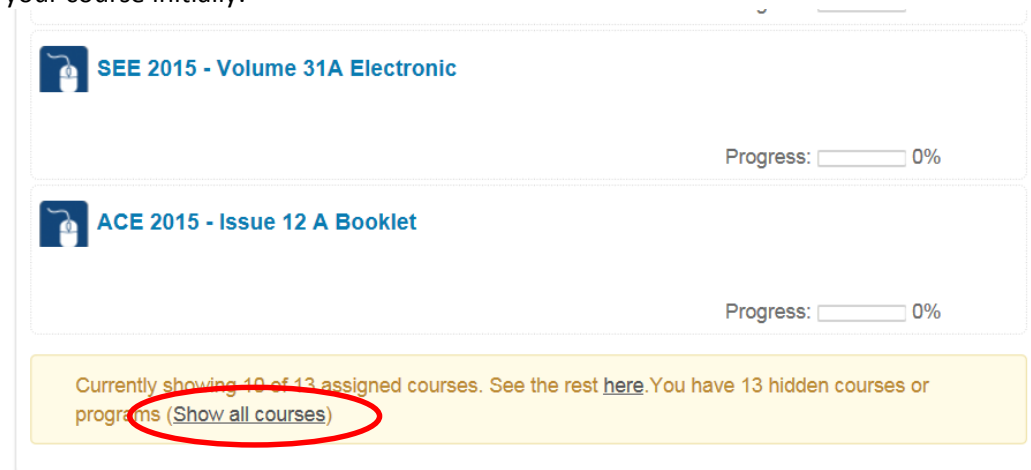
- Enter your **Email Address on file with ASA** and **Password**, and select **Login**.

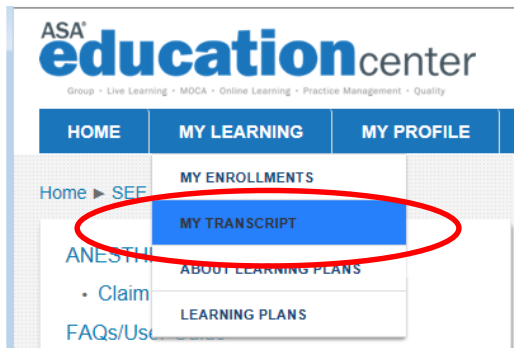
