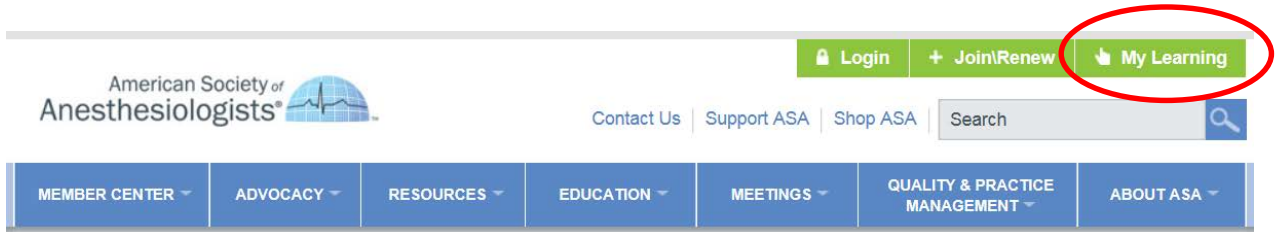


## SEE 32B Booklet Instructions

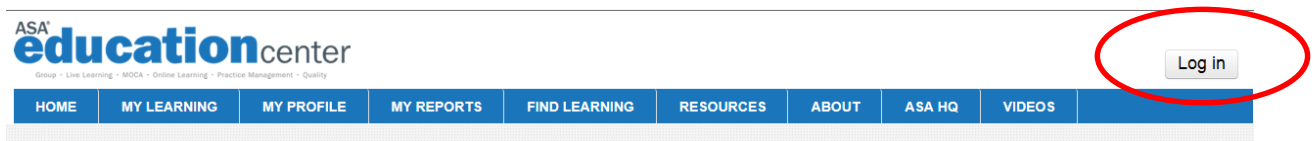
Listed below are instructions to submit your responses, complete the course evaluation and claim your CME credit for **SEE 32B Booklet** version.

- Select the **My Learning** button at the top right of the page.

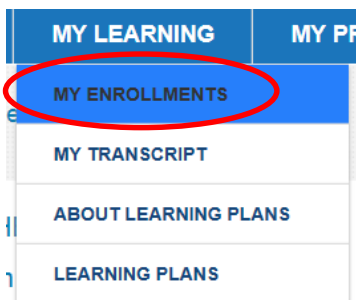


- Select **Log in** at the top of the page.



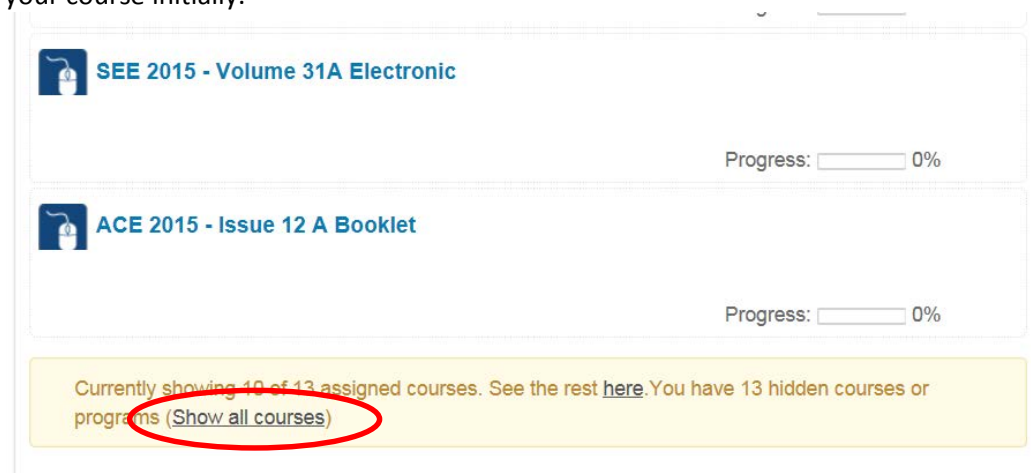
- Enter your **Email Address on file with ASA** and **Password**, and select **Login**.

2. Under the **My Learning** tab at the top of the page select **My Enrollments** from the drop-down menu.

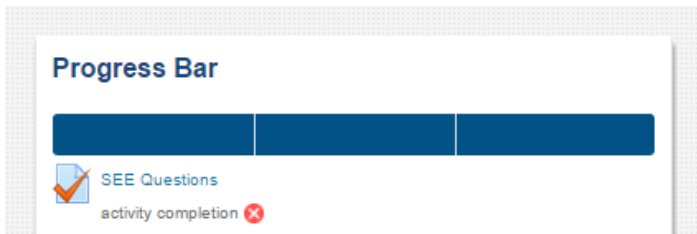


3. Select **SEE 2016 – Volume 32B Booklet** from your list of courses.

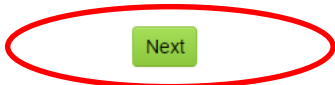

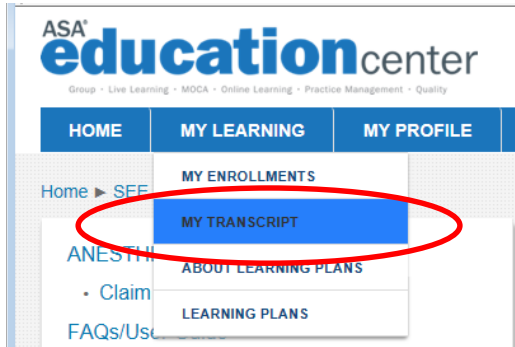
