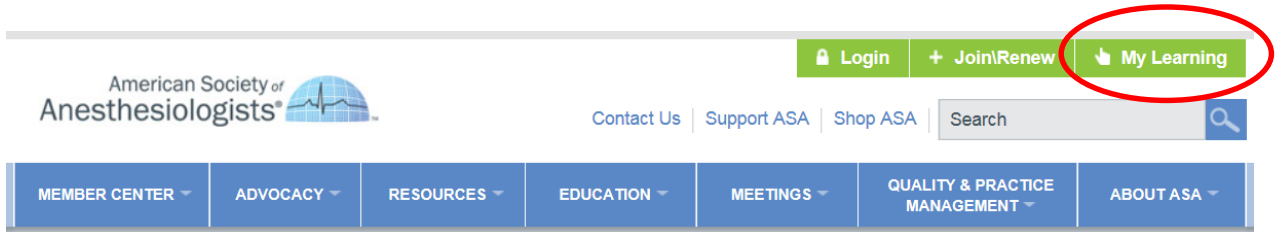

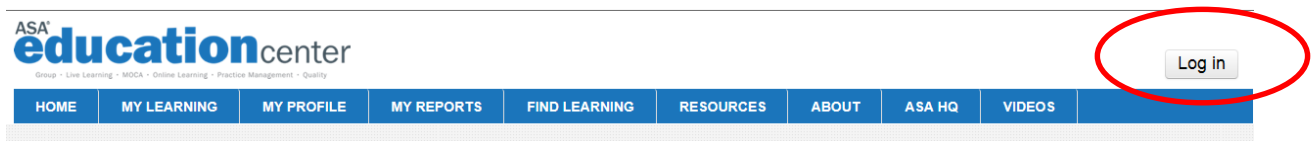
Listed below are instructions to submit your responses, complete the course evaluation and claim your credits for **SEE 33A Electronic** version.

1. Go to **www.asahq.org**.

- Select the **My Learning** button at the top right of the page.

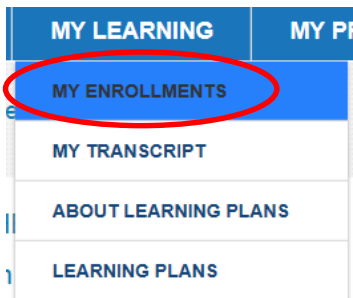


- Select **Log in** at the top of the page.



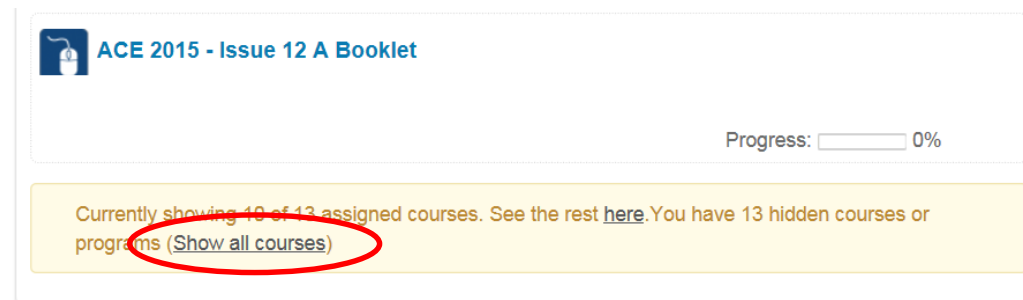
- Enter your **Email Address on file with ASA** and **Password**, and select **Login**.

2. Under the **My Learning** tab at the top of the page select **My Enrollments** from the drop-down menu.

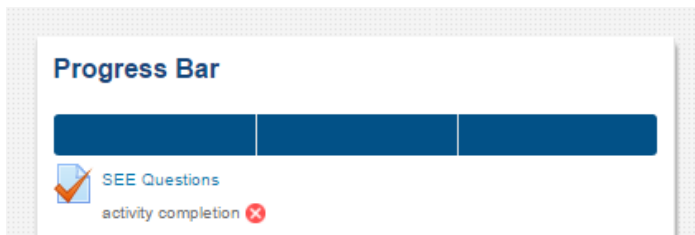


3. Select **SEE 2017 – Volume 33A Electronic** from your list of courses.

Apixaban is a factor Xa inhibitor used to reduce the risk of stroke associated with chronic nonvalvular atrial fibrillation and the risk of deep vein thrombosis. One concern with the drug is the lack of a reversal agent, which is particularly relevant for patients who are bleeding or require an emergent invasive procedure. Andexanet alfa is an investigational agent that reverses the anticoagulant effects of apixaban. Which of the following statements about andexanet is MOST likely true?

- A. It is a monoclonal antibody directed against the apixaban molecule. **✘ Andexanet is a decoy protein that looks like a factor Xa molecule but does not inhibit or promote clot formation. It binds to direct factor Xa inhibitors and makes them unavailable as anticoagulants.**
- B. A single bolus provides reversal for 12 hours.
- C. It reverses the anticoagulant effects of apixaban within minutes of bolus dosing.
- D. Apixaban is the only factor Xa inhibitor reversed by andexanet.

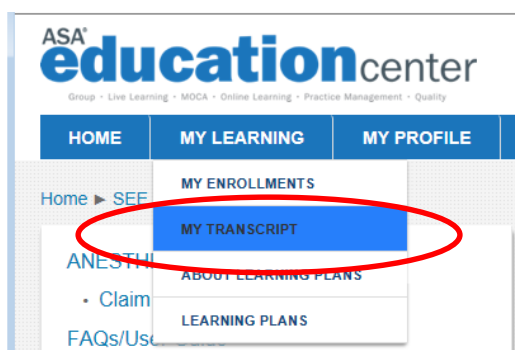
